General Description:

Glendale United Methodist Church is a growing congregation in Nashville, TN that is justice-seeking and Reconciling (LGBTQIA+ affirming). Glendale's Youth Director will be responsible for leading and coordinating all youth activities and programs within our community of faith. This role is responsible for creating and nurturing a welcoming and inclusive environment for young people of all backgrounds and abilities to grow spiritually, socially, and emotionally.

Specific Responsibilities:

- 1. Continue to develop our youth ministry program that is in line with Glendale's mission to be a safe community of faith for all people.
- 2. Plan and implement engaging youth gatherings, including weekly youth group meetings after worship, service projects, and events.
- 3. Foster a safe and supportive space where youth can explore their faith, ask questions, and develop meaningful relationships with each other and with God.
- 4. In coordination with church leaders, recruit, train, and direct volunteers to assist with youth activities and events and integrate youth into the broader church community and ministry efforts.
- 5. Develop relationships and connections within our community of faith through worship and churchwide events.
- 6. Communicate regularly with youth, their families, and church leaders to keep them informed about upcoming events, opportunities, and resources.
- 7. Ensure compliance with Glendale's Safe Sanctuaries Policies and Procedures, including those related to youth protection and safety.

Job Qualifications:

- 1. A strong commitment to the values of inclusivity, diversity, and social justice which will create a safe space for all youth, including those within marginalized communities (minorities, LGBTQIA+, neurodivergent, etc.).
- 2. Must be at least 23 years of age (Our Safe Sanctuary Policy states this staff role should be 5 years older than the oldest youth).
- 3. Excellent interpersonal and communications skills, with the ability to relate to youth of all ages and backgrounds.
- 4. An understanding of United Methodist theology, or willingness to learn, is necessary for this role.
- 5. Must pass a background check and take the Safe Gatherings training before working with our youth group.
